# PARTS OF A COMPOUND BOW



**A** - Upper Limb

**B** - Lower Limb

**C** - Front Sight

**D** - Cam

**E** - Grip

**F** - Cable Guard

**G** - Cables

**H** - Arrow Shelf

**I** - Nocking Loop

**A** - Nock

**B** - Fletchings

**C** - Index Feather

**D** - Shaft

**E** - Point
