

Basic Archery Rules

- 1. Follow the directions of the range commander
- 2. Always use proper safety equipment arm guard, finger tab, glove
- Wear appropriate archery clothes nothing loose fitting, hair tied back, large earrings out, no hangey bracelets, closed toe shoes
- 4. **Use only your arrows** Don't swap with anyone or lose track of what yours look like arrow length matters
- 5. **Let dropped arrows lay** You must wait for the range commander to give permission to pick it up
- 6. **Never dry fire your bow** This can cause lots of damage to the bow!
- 7. **Walking only on the archery range** Even if you're not carrying any archery gear, it's never a good idea to horseplay and not be aware of what's going on.
- 8. **Keep arrows in the quiver until you hear the single whistle command to shoot** No holding an arrow in your hand to "be ready"
- 9. **Be familiar with all the whistle meanings** 1 = OK to shot, 2 = Archers to the shooting line, 3 = score and retrieve arrows 4 = Emergency, cease fire!
- 10. **Be aware of what's behind your target** Where will your arrow go if you miss?













